FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Who is eligible to receive the H1N1 vaccination?

- *Any person greater than 6 months in age is eligible to receive the H1N1 vaccination.*

What type of vaccine will be available?

- *Both age appropriate intramuscular injection (shot) and nasal mist will be available.*

Who should not be vaccinated with the H1N1 vaccination?

- *People who have a severe allergy to chicken eggs*
- *People who have had a severe reaction to an influenza vaccination*
- *People who developed Guillain-Barre Syndrome (GBS) within 6 weeks of receiving an influenza vaccine previously*
- *Children younger than 6 months of age (influenza vaccine for this age group is not approved for this age group) and,*
- *People who have a moderate-to-severe illness with fever (they should wait to recover better to get vaccinated).*
